Cookie Policy

Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on your computer by websites you visit. They are widely used to make websites work or run more efficiently, as well as to provide information to The Scheme. Cookies can't harm your computer.

There are two types of cookies:

- *Session (Transient) cookies*: These cookies are erased when you close your browser and do not collect information from your computer. They typically store information in the form of a session identification that does not personally identify the user.
- *Persistent (Permanent or Stored) cookies*: These cookies are stored on your hard drive until they expire (ie they are based on a set expiration date) or until you delete them. These cookies are used to collect identifying information about the user, such as web surfing behaviour or user preferences for a specific site.

Policy

To get the most from our website, your computer, tablet or mobile phone will need to accept cookies. However, you can restrict, block or delete cookies from The Scheme at any time by changing the cookie preferences in your browser. As each browser is different, please consult your browser's "Help" function or your phone or tablet's manual to find out how to customise your cookie settings. Please remember, if you turn off your cookies, some features of this site may not work correctly. The Scheme does not store sensitive information in the cookies we create, but we do use encrypted information gathered from them to help improve your experience of the site.
